## Gifts received for Lainat Home

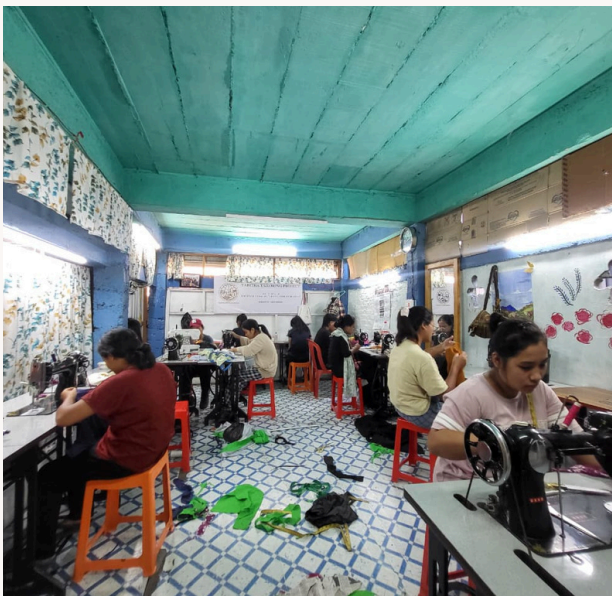
